**DATE**: January 19, 2016

Pursuant to Technical Notice <u>15-008</u>, the Montréal Exchanges wishes to inform its approved participants, software and data vendors that the new Eris-based Canadian Dollar Interest Rate Swap Futures contract and the enhancement to the Request for Quote (RFQ) functionality will be available in the General Test Environment (GTE) as of January 25, 2016. Please note that trades on Swap Futures contract executed in the MX GTE environment will not flow through CDCC's system.

## General Test Environment (GTE) and Certification Preparation

In order to support the enhanced RFQ function, a standard certification test is mandatory on SAIL, FIX and HSVF multicast (D4). MX also requires an HSVF multicast (D4) certification test to support the new Swap futures contract.

Application testing and support is available Mondays through Fridays, from 8:00 a.m. ET to 4:30 p.m. ET. After-hours testing is available, without support, on Mondays through Fridays, from 1:00 a.m. ET to 8:00 a.m. ET and from 4:30 p.m. ET to 10:30 p.m. ET.
