Value

- Two (2) graduate scholarships (M.Sc., DES, MBA, EMBA) of \$10,000
- Two (2) postgraduate scholarships (Ph.D., DBA, EDBA) of \$25,000

Field of studies

Finance, mathematics, economy, financial engineering, strategy, accounting, actuarial or any other related discipline

Eligibility conditions

- Be registered in a full-time graduate or postgraduate program in a Canadian university.
- Conduct a research project (essay, paper, thesis or article) on exchange-traded derivatives or any topic related to the Montréal Exchange's business.
- Conduct a research project in whole or in part during the referred academic year of The Canadian Derivatives Exchange Scholars Program.

Required documents

- Applicant's form duly completed
- Plan of the research project (two pages maximum)
- Letter of motivation (one page maximum)
- Curriculum vitae (CV)
- Official transcript of all previous university studies
- Two referrals or evaluation forms (to your choice) submitted individually at www.m-x.ca/scholars. One of the referrals must be from the Research Director and the second can be academic or professional.
