#### Listing of S&P/TSX 60 ESG Index Futures (SEG)

Pursuant to Advisory Notice A20-010, Bourse de Montréal Inc. (the "Bourse") wishes to inform market participants that it will list its new S&P/TSX 60 ESG Index Futures at the opening of trading at 9:30 am (ET) on Monday, December 14, 2020, subject to the completion of the self-certification process as established under the Derivatives Act (CQLR, Chapter I-14.01) and, when applicable, to obtaining final regulatory approvals.

In preparation for the launch, the Bourse invites market participants and key stakeholders to test their systems. The new contract specifications can be found below.

The Bourse will list four (4) quarterly contracts starting with the March 2021 expiry as well as intra-group strategies (calendar spreads) and Basis Trade on Close (BTC) instruments. The following futures contracts will be listed at the open of trading on December 14, 2020.
