**IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THE MARCH 2008  
OPTIONS AND FUTURES EXPIRIES**

We remind you that the last trading day for the March 2008 expiry for options and futures expiries coincides with Good Friday, which is a scheduled holiday for the Bourse de Montréal Inc. (the Bourse) and the Canadian Derivatives Clearing Corporation (CDCC).

The Bourse and CDCC would like to inform all market participants that, in order to take into consideration the scheduled holiday, the last trading day and expiration date for options and futures will be:
