## HEARING BEFORE THE DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE OF **BOURSE DE MONTRÉAL INC.**

## TIMBER HILL CANADA COMPANY

Bourse de Montréal Inc. (the Bourse) will hold a hearing before the Disciplinary Committee of the Bourse on March 26, 2013 at 8:30 am, in connection with a disciplinary complaint filed against Timber Hill Canada Company, an approved participant of the Bourse.

The disciplinary complaint filed by the Bourse claims that during the period between October 4, 2011 to January 26, 2012, Timber Hill Canada Company contravened article 3011 of the Rules of the Bourse, when it did not establish and maintain a system to supervise the activities of each employee, reasonably designed to achieve compliance with the Rules of the Bourse, especially with regards to thirteen (13) transactions whose execution did not result in any change in the beneficial or economic ownership of the relevant derivative instruments.

Subject to situations provided for under article 4154 of the Rules of the Bourse, all hearings before the Disciplinary Committee of the Bourse are held in public.
