Weekly Options Expansion of Number of Weekly Options Classes And Classes that Will Graduate to Multiple Weekly Options

On November 10, 2015 Bourse de Montréal Inc. (the Bourse) announced, in circular 133-15, the launch of Multiple weekly options as part of the weekly project. This project began on December 4, 2014 (circular 137-14) with the launch of weekly options on ten (10) classes of equity and exchange-traded fund (ETF) options. The Bourse would like to inform its participants that as of June 1, 2016, the number of weekly option classes will increase from 25 to 30.
