## Addition of 10 classes to new Options Expiry Cycle

As stated previously in circular 032-21, Bourse de Montréal Inc., ''The Bourse" is incrementally adding classes to our new Options expiry cycle (from most active to least active based on 2020 trading volume) each month for a duration of 6 months.

The new cycle will be introduced in all classes and will consist of four (4) consecutive months with two (2) quarterly expiries.

Here are the 10 option classes being added to the new cycle for the opening of trading on Monday April 19, 2021:
