CHANGE TO THE CURRENCY OPTION SYMBOL

Bourse de Montréal Inc. (the Bourse) and Canadian Derivatives Clearing Corporation (CDCC) hereby inform all option participants that on Friday, May 23, 2008 a symbol modification will occur for existing series of options on the U.S. dollar (USZ).

The Bourse and CDCC will adjust existing series from stock option strike prices of ninety-five dollars and fifty cents (\$95.50) to one hundred and five dollars (\$105.00) inclusive back to the original symbol USX.
