**XEBEC ADSORPTION INC. (XBC)
SUSPENSION**

The Bourse de Montréal inc. (the « Bourse ») and the Canadian Derivatives Clearing Corporation (« CDCC ») wish to inform you that the Toronto Stock Exchange announced on September 29, 2022, that the common shares of Xebec Adsorption Inc. (“Xebec”) are suspended. The trading of Xebec options at Montreal Exchange is suspended at the present time.

The Auto-Exercise function will not be available for Xebec. Manual exercises only are permitted and must be processed manually by the member firm.

If a decision to exercise is taken, holders of the Put options will need to make provisions to be able to deliver the stock.
