Numerical Example

For a member holding a long put strike \$8.00 position and considering that HXD Fund's closing price on November 25, 2015 is \$5.19, the intrinsic value of the option prior to the adjustment is:

Intrinsic Value = \$8.00 x 100 - \$5.19 x 100 = \$281.00

After the adjustment, the intrinsic value of the option will be:

Intrinsic Value = New Strike Price x New Multiplier – New Underlying Price x New Deliverable = \$16.00 x 50 - \$10.38 x 50 = \$281.00
