ANTICIPATED CONTRACT ADJUSTMENT Highpine Oil & Gas Ltd (HPX) Acquisition

The Bourse and CDCC wish to inform you that Highpine Oil & Gas Ltd ("Highpine") and Daylight Resources Trust ("Daylight") announced on August 23, 2009, that they have negociated an arrangement agreement where Daylight will acquire all of the issued and outstanding common shares of Highpine. Under the terms of the proposed agreement, Highpine common shareholders will receive a cash amount of C\$7.00, or 0.85 of a Daylight trust unit, or a combination subject to a proration based upon a maximum of \$75 million in cash, for each share held. A special meeting is scheduled for October 7, 2009, at which time Highpine shareholders will have the opportunity to vote on the proposed plan of arrangement.

The transaction is subject to approval by the shareholders of Highpine and certain customary approvals. The companies anticipate that the transaction should be completed around mid-October 2009.
